

CAREERS RELATED ACTIVITIES LINKED TO EDUCATIONAL VIDEOS AND DOCUMENTARIES (KS3 AND KS4)

OVERVIEW

This series of activities will allow students with the opportunity to improve their knowledge and understanding of the world of work. After watching a specific careers related video or documentary students will be required to share their thoughts, feedback and knowledge gained in written form.

This activity will be expanded upon by asking students to conduct some further research into the job roles featured within the videos / documentaries and then answer a series of further questions relating to the job roles / industry sectors which have been featured.

KS3 students will be required to provide basic careers related information as part of this activity.

KS4 Students will undertake similar activities but will also be required to undertake more detailed research which will also include the use of labour market information.

This series of activities will cover the following industry sectors – General Careers / STEM / Hospitality / Creative and Healthcare.
